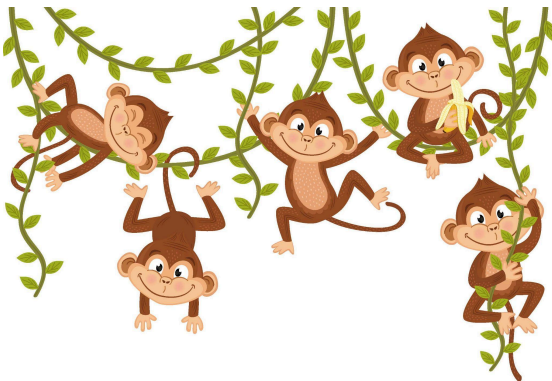
**(FK 2.4) Title: Sam's Big Adventure**
