Teachers can all log in using the username: *teacher@pearson.com* and the password: *PearsonTeacher1*

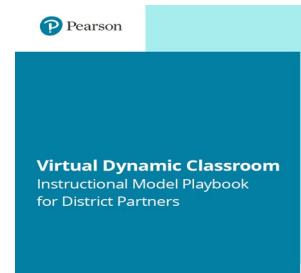
These logins are generic because there is no student data stored in Vista, so this is essentially just a key to view the activities and the textbook

The new Pearson Curriculum including reference to pronoun inclusivity may be found in the following courses:

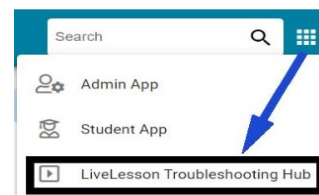
- English Language Arts (ELA) 6A - Unit 3 Lesson 1 - All States
